



2 YEAR FUNDING MYTH BUSTING

- **YOU CAN ONLY GET 2 YEAR FUNDING IF YOU DON'T WORK**

Not true, you can earn up to £16,190 before tax per year and be eligible for 2 year funding, if you are claiming tax credits. Or earning £15,400 or less a year, after tax' and claiming Universal Credit.

- **I HAVE A CHILD IN RECEIPT OF 30 HOURS FUNDING, SO WON'T BE ELIGIBLE FOR FUNDING FOR A YOUNGER SIBLING**

Not true, eligibility for 30 hours funding is assessed by the number of hour's parent's work, while the 2 year funding is assessed on income.



2 YEAR FUNDING MYTH BUSTING

- **IF YOU GET 2 YEAR FUNDING YOU CAN'T CLAIM ANY FURTHER HELP.**

Not True, With 2 year funding the first 15 hours are free and parents can also apply for and may be entitled to:

Tax-Free childcare and receive up to £2000 per child (for working families)

Universal credit and receive up to 85% of childcare costs (for working families)

Tax credits and receive up to 70% of childcare costs (for working families)

Student finance and received up to 85% of childcare cost.
